LOCAL BOOK CELEBRATES SUCCESS WITH SECOND EDITION

A locally produced book containing the stories of eleven women from diverse cultural backgrounds celebrates its success with the recent release of its second edition. ***Between the lines – stories of 11 women*** was published in October 2008 and sold out of the first print run of 500 books within a month. The second edition is now available.

The eleven stories in this handsome little volume reveal the unifying themes in the lives of women everywhere. With a forward by Virginia Haussegger, the book contains stories by women who were all resident of Canberra at the time of publication. The writers are from rural Australia, Singapore, Italy, the USA, England, Sri Lanka, South Yemen and Indonesia. There are also stories by an Aboriginal woman and one born in Australia of European Jewish parents.

Some of the writers will be signing these second edition books at Paperchain Bookstore Manuka on Friday 8 May from 6-8pm and at Daltons Bookstore Civic on Saturday 9 May from 11am-1pm.

The book is a good quality production of 256 pages, produced and printed in Canberra. Retailing for \$20 it makes a worthy addition to any home library and appeals as a Mothers' Day gift that keeps its value long after the day has passed.
